

# Background KDBP

- KDBP has been around for approx.
  30 years.
- Funded through OSEP and KDE
- State DeafBlind Projects are Technical Assistance Projects (not direct service)
- All services are free

- KDBP covers the entire state of Kentucky. (only 3 staff)
- Housed at University of Kentucky
- Provides services to families and service providers
- Works with early intervention, school teams, and adult services

### What do we do??

- Maintain the KDBP census
- Collaborate with state partners to improve services for children/youth ages 0-22 who have a dual sensory loss of vision and hearing.
- We are not direct service....instead we provide training and coaching to families, educational teams, first steps providers, and adult services.

# What is unique about individuals who are deafblind?

#### Individuals who are deafblind are:

- Highly diverse
- Lowest incidence disability group
- 90% have 1 additional disability
- 43% have 4 or more additional disabilities
- Loss of distal senses and connection to the world beyond their fingertips
- Currently 160 on our census....probably twice that.

- Provide training

- Access to intervenor modules
- Invitation to ECC Week

# ECC Week (Expanded Core Curriculum)

- Collaboration with Office for Vocational Rehab, KDBP, UK Vision Program, EKU D/HH Program
- Hands on experiences that explore job opportunities, identify skills of strength and needing support, planning for the future.
- Brings together school, home, and VR
